Day 1:

Explore with a Green

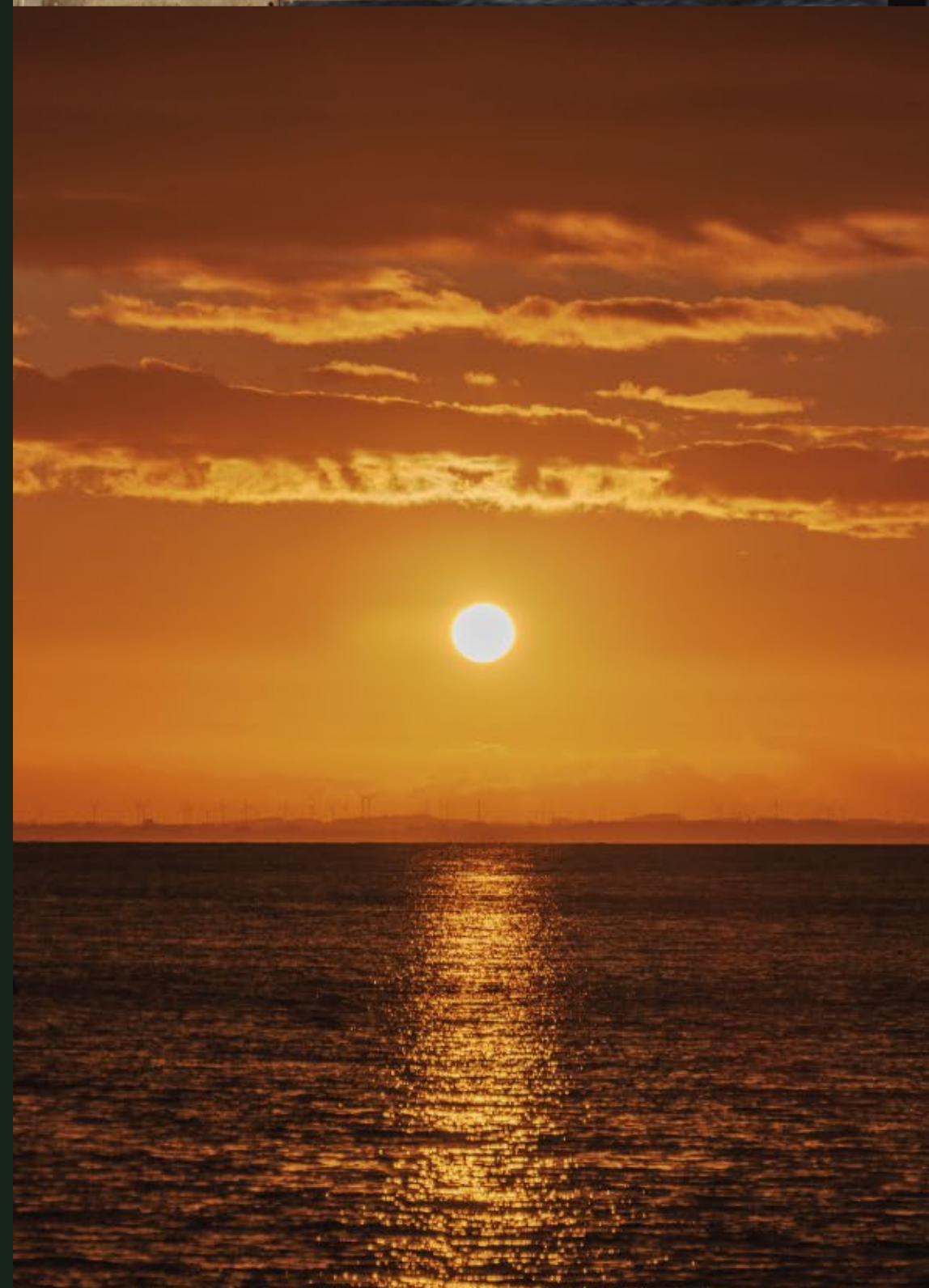
Touch: *Afternoon* Electric Bike Excursion

For those eager to explore in the afternoon, an eco-friendly option is available to reduce the carbon footprint: an excursion using electric bikes. Guests can glide along the scenic Pichijuan and Los Riscos routes, immersing themselves in the stunning natural beauty of the Lake Llanquihue area while minimizing environmental impact. This sustainable adventure allows guests to experience the landscape while contributing to the hotel's commitment to preserving the environment.

Sunset at Osorno *Volcano*

For a unique experience, guests can embark on an optional excursion to Osorno Volcano. As they ascend, they will be accompanied by stunning views of Lake Llanquihue, culminating in a beautiful sunset. Guests can enjoy this majestic moment from the chairlift, where panoramic views of the lake and surrounding volcanoes create an unforgettable scene.

At the evening guests will savor the flavors of the region with gourmet dishes crafted from fresh ingredients sourced directly from the organic garden and local products.





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Day 2

The day begins with a delicious breakfast featuring locally sourced products to energize guests for the morning's activities. That day they can choose between exploring the traditional craft of basketmaking or loom-weaving by visiting the communities and local workshops of Carretera Austral.

Basketmaking or *Loom-Weaving*

Guests will discover the art of natural dyeing, spindle spinning, and weaving, learning about techniques that have been passed down through generations.

In May 2023, the World Crafts Council honored the sister villages of Ilque and Huelmo as Craft Cities of the World for their exceptional basketmaking and loom-weaving traditions, which pre-date Hispanic culture and have been preserved by local artisans for over 150 years. These techniques, rooted in the cultures of Chilean canoe travelers from Chiloé and Calbuco in the mid-19th century, continue to thrive today. Through these excursions, Hotel AWA, a certified B Corporation, supports the community and the great work of "Artesanías de Chile" Foundation in preserving these generational techniques and traditions.

Parque Alerce *Andino Hike*

In the afternoon, guests will embark on a scenic excursion along the Carretera Austral to Alerce Andino National Park, a sanctuary for one of the last ancient alerce forests. Nestled among volcanoes, valleys, and the Pacific Ocean, this park protects majestic trees that are over 3,000 years old and reach heights of over 40 meters. As guests hike along an old logging road, they will ascend to see a 3,500-year-old alerce and explore a unique ecosystem that is home to diverse wildlife.





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Day 3

Guests begin the day with an e-bike excursion to the stunning Saltos del Petrohué waterfalls, with scenic views of Osorno Volcano. In the afternoon, they can choose between hiking the "El Solitario" trail or navigating Todos los Santos Lake, followed by a relaxing evening at the hotel with spa treatments, a cocktail at the dock, and sunset views.

Ebike Excursion to Petrohué *Waterfalls*

The morning adventure begins with a trip east toward Ensenada, located on the bay of the same name. From there, guests will continue slightly north to the Saltos del Petrohué. Along the way, they will enjoy views of the majestic Osorno Volcano, its ancient lahar fields, the ash from Calbuco Volcano's 2015 eruption, and the fast-flowing Petrohué River. The Saltos del Petrohué are a series of waterfalls cascading over volcanic rock shaped by Osorno's eruptions. Guests will explore trails and stop at an overlook to admire the stunning emerald waters and the sheer power of the river.

El Solitario Hike or *Navigation* "Todos los Santos" Lake

For the afternoon excursion, guests have two options: exploring "El Solitario," a trail within Vicente Pérez Rosales National Park, or embarking on a journey across the emerald waters of Todos los Santos Lake. The "El Solitario" trail follows an old route along the southern slope of Osorno Volcano, offering stunning views of Osorno and Calbuco Volcanoes, as well as beautiful vistas of the surrounding nature. Alternatively, guests can take a guided boat journey on Todos los Santos Lake, surrounded by the majestic Osorno, Puntagudo, and Tronador volcanoes, while learning about the unique details of the route.

Afterward, guests return to the hotel to enjoy the benefits of the spa and restaurant, experiencing personalized service that makes them feel at home—only better. Before dinner, guests can treat themselves to a cocktail at the dock, soaking in breathtaking views of the lake and surrounding volcanoes. As the sun sets, they can savor their drink by the warmth of a bonfire, creating the perfect atmosphere for relaxation.





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Day 4

Guests start their day by exploring AWA's organic garden and participating in a farm-to-table experience, including a cooking class with freshly harvested ingredients. The afternoon offers relaxation options at the hotel, such as enjoying the heated pool, jacuzzi, sauna, or massages. The day concludes with a gourmet meal featuring local cuisine.

Farm to table **A Favorite *Excursion* at** **AWA: A Journey from Farm to Table**

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On this day, guests can choose between a full-day “Desolacion” Hike in the national park, offering stunning views and insights into the Southern Andes, or a scenic journey around Lake Llanquihue, exploring historic towns like Puerto Varas, Llanquihue, and Frutillar. The day ends with relaxation at the hotel and a gourmet meal with selected local products.

Full-Day Excursion: Desolación Hike

The day begins with a delicious breakfast at the hotel before embarking on a captivating hike through the La Picada sector of the National Park. Once home to Chile’s first mountain refuge and ski center, this trail offers a 40-minute ascent to a scenic pass with breathtaking views of Todos los Santos Lake and the surrounding volcanoes. The descent leads to the stunning beaches of Petrohué, with expert guides providing insights into the unique volcanic and glacial features of the Southern Andes. This excursion is ideal for trekking enthusiasts and nature photographers.

Full-Day Excursion: Scenic Journey Around Lake Llanquihue

The journey begins in Puerto Varas, exploring the charming Decher Street neighborhood rich in historical heritage. The trip proceeds to Llanquihue, known for its industrial roots and German heritage. Continuing along the picturesque Punta Larga inland road towards Frutillar, guests will be captivated by panoramic views of the majestic volcanoes: Puntagudo, Osorno, Calbuco, and Casablanca. In Frutillar, guests will visit the renowned Teatro del Lago and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Afterward, they will immerse themselves in the history of the German colonial museum and visit Puerto Octay. The journey concludes with a scenic drive back to the hotel, passing through the beautiful Cascadas and Ensenada, completing a memorable circuit around Lake Llanquihue.

Upon returning to the hotel, guests can relax in tranquil spaces such as the spa or their room with a soothing lake view. The experience continues with a delightful meal at the restaurant.
